2022 SUPPLY CHAIN CHALLENGES

What To Expect?

The demand for custom cedar home packages has never been higher.

However, the shipping procedure and material supply have been hampered because of the Covid epidemic and consequent supply chain delays.

Maintaining a large inventory of all components is an excellent business strategy to avoid supply issues, but we're having some issues with specific supplies, particularly trusses, windows, and composite siding.

The good news is that purchase and inventories have been increased to ensure that timber, plywood, and OSB are available for at least six months.

This safeguards customers against supply chain disruptions while ensuring pricing on unpredictable commodities.

The materials unique to the customers' house package, on the other hand, may create delays.

Priority has been to order these items earlier than ever before, but supplier and supply chain bottlenecks have hampered progress.

Nature can provide you with the color you desire. Sky blue or leafy greens are popular colors, as is red for a more traditional look.


Combine with hits of magenta or lavender if you want a more current "look."

2022 HOUSING MARKET FORECAST

Build where the buyers are.

Where population growth is strongest, more new homes are needed. Florida, Texas, North Carolina, Arizona, and Georgia had the biggest net population growth between 2020 and 2021.

Idaho, Utah, Montana, Arizona, and South Carolina had the highest net growth rates in percentage terms. New-home demand will be driven by population increase in the South and Mountain West.

The Suburbs is Still the Best Place to Live

The pandemic has shifted what Americans are looking for in a home. Homeowners who want to sell and relocate no longer need to be close to the office.

Still a fan of the suburbs

The epidemic altered consumer desires for more room and flexibility in their homes. Homebuyers and renters relocated to suburban areas and less densely populated metro areas.

While urban regions remain more expensive, moving to the suburbs allows you to find a more inexpensive house in a less competitive market. With rising mortgage rates and affordability, homeowners are flocking to the suburbs.

In 2022, what will happen to building materials?

Prices will not return to the levels seen in 2020. The increasing demand will fade over time, resulting in a small rebound.

Supply Chain Improvement

Because monetary policy continues to force prices higher, supply chains will likely remain above trend beyond 2023.

In 2022, how much will home prices rise?

Home prices are predicted to grow by 3.5 percent in the following 12 months.

Builders will continue to face difficulties in the availability of building materials and labor shortages, which will slow construction and keep home prices rising.

In comparison to a year ago, the cost of building materials has increased by 21%.

As builders strive to increase production to meet increased demand, their pricing and availability, as well as ongoing supply chain problems, remain the most pressing challenges.

Affordability will decrease in the coming year as mortgage rates rise, construction prices rise, and construction labor becomes scarce.

Cedar Home Packages provide homebuyers with a customized, energy-efficient building alternative that is often less expensive than traditionally built homes.



You may get a lot more for your money with a customized cedar home.


For starters, new construction is typically larger, with a median size of 2,594 square feet, resulting in lower construction costs per square foot than existing homes.

Most operating cargo ships around the globe are currently stuck in traffic outside of busy ports. China accounts for about a third of the backlog.


Ships are now awaiting outside Shanghai, the world's largest port, as well as other Chinese cargo ports.

As the weather warms, this practical measure will ensure that your home is pleasant and comfortable.


4. CLEAN ALL OF YOUR DOOR SCREENS AND WINDOWS

Fill one bucket with a cup of vinegar and the other with a cup of ammonia on an overcast day. After that, fill one bucket with hot water and the other with warm water.

Scrub your windows with the vinegar-ammonia mixture first, then warm water, then squeegee drying.





Goats Cheese and Vegetable Frittata



INGREDIENTS

- 16 eggs
- 2 bunches broccolini, trimmed and chopped into 2cm pieces
- 1 cup (120g) baby peas
- 1/4 cup finely chopped chives, plus 1 tbs extra
- 300g soft goat's cheese, crumbled
- 2 zucchini, cut into matchsticks (we used a julienne peeler)
- ¼ cup (60ml) extra virgin olive oil
- 200g mixed cherry tomatoes, halved
- ¼ cup (loosely packed) dill sprigs
- 1 tbs white wine vinegar

INSTRUCTIONS

1.Preheat the oven to 200°C. Whisk together eggs and ¾ cup (180ml) water in a large bowl. Stir in the broccolini, peas, chives, three-quarters of the goat's cheese, and half the zucchini, and season. Heat 2 tbs of the oil in a 24cm non-stick frying pan over medium heat. Pour in the egg mixture and cook for 2 minutes or until the edges start to set. Transfer to the oven and bake for 30-35 minutes until set and golden. Set aside to rest for 5 minutes.

2.Make a tomato salad by combining the tomatoes, half the dill, the extra chives, vinegar, and remaining oil in a bowl and season.

3.Top the frittata with remaining goat's cheese, zucchini, and dill, and serve with the tomato salad.
